1. LEVELS:

Intro through FEI Grand Prix Special. GAIG/USDF Qualifying, Young Horse, Opportunity Classes, Para-Equestrian, FEI Pony Classes, USEF Rider Tests, Materiale Classes and Freestyles.

⁻ If entries warrant, classes will be divided into Adult Amateur and/or Junior/Young Rider.

Please indicate your status on your entry.

2. AWARDS:

- Trophy and six ribbons in each class. Classes may be divided if entries warrant.
- Prizes, ribbon and medal for high score ride on Saturday and ribbon for high score ride on Sunday for USEF (T-4), Opportunity (T-1) and FEI (PSG-GP) levels, Adult Amateur, JR/YR and Open divisions.
- Award for high score ride of the weekend by a CVDA member.
- Breed awards for high score for weekend (for each day when breed organizations will support two awards) will be offered. All high score and breed awards exclude Intro, Freestyle, Young Horse, JR/YR Team/Individual, Opportunity, Pony, Rider's Tests and Para-Equestrian classes.
- Classes #123 & #223: USDF/Dover Adult Amateur prize awarded to highest scoring AA ride 60% or higher.

NOTE: It is the competitors' responsibility to pick up awards. They will not be mailed.

3. ENTRIES

Each competition must be on a separate entry form, and must include separate fees for each day (exception: stabling is paid <u>once</u> for the weekend). Class fees are per class.

- •Mail entries to the Show Secretary *postmarked on or after the opening date and by the closing date*. Accepted checks will be cashed upon receipt. Wait list entries checks will be held. If an opening occurs, they will be notified and if they agree to enter their checks will be cashed.
- •<u>If paying with a credit card</u>, please note the card number, expiration date and code on the entry form, along with a signature, and include your e-mail address.
- •Post entries will be accepted with NO ADDITIONAL FEE if time and space allows.
- •All entries must include a current negative Coggins Certificate and a Vet Certified Rabies Vaccination Certificate dated after August 12, 2015, and copies of all USEF/USDF cards are required with entry.
- •Refunds: Scratches before the closing date will receive a refund less a \$30 processing fee. No refunds after the closing date or for "acts of God" which require management to cancel classes/day(s) of competition.
- *Opportunity Classes: Riders/Horses competing only in "opportunity" classes are exempt from USEF and USDF membership requirements and do not have to pay non-member, HID or Drug fees. In addition, owners, trainers and coaches are exempt from membership requirements for these classes. All USEF Dressage Division rules (excluding membership) apply for these classes (including dress and saddlery requirements), in addition to all applicable General Rules such as Drugs and Medications. "Opportunity" riders and horses may cross enter into non-opportunity classes, but if you do so, all USEF and USDF membership requirements and fees will apply for rider, horse, owner, trainer etc. Scores earned in "opportunity" classes may not be used toward USEF or USDF awards or programs.

4. TIMES:

Tentative times will be posted by August 8, 2016 at *www.vermontdressagedays.com* Official show times will be available in the show office. Please check with the office for day sheets to confirm ride times on show days.

5. STABLING:

Stabling will be offered on a first come, first served basis.

\$145.00 block stabling for the duration of the show (Friday 10 AM – Monday 8AM).

- A separate stall cleaning deposit of \$25.00 is required and will be refunded if stalls are cleaned upon departure. Flying Hooves 4H will be on-site and will clean stalls for a donation.
- 58 Permanent stalls (10 x 12) with full doors, 36 permanent shed row stalls (10 x 12) with half doors. All permanent stalls have clay floors. Temporary stalls (10 x 10) will be erected if entries warrant.
- Stabling assignments will be posted on the website by August 10th.
- VDD will not provide bedding, but shavings will be left your stall if you request and pay on your entry form \$6.00 per bag. Shavings will be available on the grounds as well.

6. COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS:

The show website, *www.vermontdressagedays.com* will be used to keep competitors informed. Prize list changes, tentative ride times, stabling assignments, entry forms, area accommodations, directions and other information will be posted to the website by the show manager. Please include your e-mail address on the entry as e-mail is our preferred method of communication. All changes and cancellations must be in writing, preferably by e-mail.

7. ACCOMMODATIONS:

- See the show website, *www.vermontdressagedays.com*, for links to area hotels offering preferred rates for competitors, as well as information on other area accommodations.

8. ENTERTAINMENT

- Food available on the grounds, starting at 6:30AM on show days.
- Competitors Party on Saturday night on the showgrounds
- "Vendor Village" located between the shed-row barn and Ring 2 Friday afternoon Sunday.

9. FOOTING:

- Two standard regulation sized (20m x 60m) sand arenas.
- Large sand warm up arena (80' x 200').. Additional warm-up areas on grass. Lunging area on grass.
- Warm Up Arenas open at 1PM on Friday.

10. DIRECTIONS:

11. OTHER:

- USEF attire and headgear rules will apply.
- Farrier on site Saturday and Sunday. Veterinarian on-call Friday Monday AM. Contact information will be posted in the show program and in the barns. After hours emergency call system information will be posted in the final show program and in the barns.
- Horses must wear bridle numbers whenever they are being ridden or exercised (DR 121.11).
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a maximum 6' leash. Violators subject to \$30.00 bail.
- Ample day trailer parking available.
- No smoking inside the barns or in the shed-row area.
- Schedule of warm-up arenas and lunging area will be posted in the program and in the barns.
- The management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes.
