1. LEVELS

Intro through FEI, Para-Equestrian, Intro/Training and First Level Opportunity, Freestyles, Materiale, Pony classes and Dressage Equitation.

2. AWARDS

- Trophy and six ribbons in each class. Classes may be divided if entries warrant.
- Prizes, ribbon and medal for high score ride on Saturday and ribbon for high score ride on Sunday for USEF (T-4), Opportunity (T-1) and FEI (PSG-GP) levels, Adult Amateur, JR/YR and Open divisions.
- Award for high score ride of the weekend by a CVDA member.
- Breed awards for high score each day will be offered.
- All high score and breed awards exclude Intro, Freestyle, Young Horse, JR/YR Team/ Individual, Opportunity, Pony, Rider's Tests, Equitation and Para-Equestrian classes.

NOTE: It is the competitors' responsibility to pick up awards. They will not be mailed.

3. ENTRIES

Each competition must be on a separate entry form, and must include separate fees for each day (exception: stabling is paid once for the weekend). Class fees are per class.

Checks payable to: *Vermont Dressage Days*. Credit card payments accepted via *Square*.

\$45 – Intro through Fourth Level (including “Opportunity” and Equitation classes*)

\$60 – FEI and Freestyles

\$30 – Office Fee for one show, **\$45** office fee for two show entry

\$15 – for each GAIG/USDF Qualifying Class

\$23 – USEF Drug Fee (waived for “opportunity” classes*)

\$45 – USEF Non-Member “Show Pass” (waived for “opportunity” classes*)

\$35 – USDF Non-Member Fee (waived for “opportunity” classes*)

\$ 7 - Pre -ordered, bagged shavings

\$10 – Per Change to Entry after closing date

\$35 – Non-negotiable Check Fee

\$20 – For Non-Competing Horses (plus drug fee and stabling fee if applicable)

No number fee.

- Entries accepted online through “Equestrian Entries”. Links will be posted on the show website.
- Mail entries to the Show Secretary postmarked on or after the opening date and by the closing date. Accepted checks will be cashed upon receipt. Wait list entries checks will be held. If an opening occurs, they will be notified and if they agree to enter their checks will be cashed.
- **If paying by mail with a credit card**, enter card information, signature and email address on entry form.
- Post entries will be accepted until August 5th with NO ADDITIONAL FEE (\$25 late entry fee after 8/5) if time and space allows.
- All entries must include a current negative Coggins Certificate and a Vet Certified Rabies Vaccination Certificate dated after August 12, 2018, and copies of all USEF/USDF cards are required with entry.
- **Refunds:** Scratches before the closing date will receive a refund less a \$30 processing fee. No refunds after the closing date or for “acts of God” which require management to cancel classes/day(s) of competition.
- **All changes and cancellations must be in writing, preferably by e-mail.**
- **Opportunity Classes:** Riders/Horses competing only in “opportunity” classes are exempt from USEF and USDF membership requirements and do not have to pay non-member, HID or Drug fees. In addition, owners, trainers and coaches are exempt from membership requirements for these classes. All USEF Dressage Division rules (excluding membership) apply for these classes (including dress and saddlery requirements), in addition to all applicable General Rules such as Drugs and Medications. “Opportunity” riders and horses may cross enter into non-opportunity classes, but if you do so, all USEF and USDF membership requirements and fees will apply for rider, horse, owner, trainer etc. Scores earned in “opportunity” classes may not be used toward USEF or USDF awards or programs.

4. TIMES

Tentative times will be posted by August 7, 2019 at www.vermontdressagedays.com.

Official show times will be available in the show office. Please check with the office for day sheets to confirm ride times on show days.

5. STABLING

Stabling will be offered on a first come, first served basis.

\$145.00 block stabling for the duration of the show (Friday 10 AM – Monday 8AM).

- A separate stall cleaning deposit of \$25.00 is required and will be refunded if stalls are cleaned upon departure. Flying Hooves 4H will clean stalls for a donation of your stall deposit.
- 58 Permanent (full door) stalls (10x12), 36 permanent shed row (half door) stalls (10x12). All stalls have clay floors. Temporary stalls (10x10) will be erected on sand if entries warrant.
- Stabling assignments will be posted on the website by August 8th.
- VDD will not provide bedding, bagged shavings available for \$7.00 per bag.

6. COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

The show website, www.vermontdressagedays.com will be used to keep competitors informed.

7. ACCOMMODATIONS

- See the show website, www.vermontdressagedays.com, for links to area hotels offering preferred rates for competitors, as well as information on other area accommodations.

8. ENTERTAINMENT

- Food available on the grounds, starting at 6:30AM on show days.
- Competitors Party on Saturday night on the showgrounds.
- “Vendor Village” located between the shed-row barn and Ring 2 Friday afternoon - Sunday.

9. FOOTING

- **Two standard regulation sized (20m x 60m) sand arenas.**
- **Large sand warm up arena (80' x 200').**
- Additional warm-up areas on grass. Lunging area on grass.
- Warm Up Arenas open at 1PM on Friday.

From Upstate New York

Take Lake Champlain/Grand Isle Ferry (fee) from Cumberland’s Head Island to North Hero, VT. Take Route 2 East to Route 2A in Colchester. Take Route 2A to Susie Wilson Rd. Right on Susie Wilson to Rte 15. Left on Rte 15 to Fairgrounds entrance on your left.

From Boston/NH/Southern Vermont

Take I-89 North to Exit 12 (Williston). Take a right turn onto Route 2A for approximately 4 miles to the 5 corners in Essex Junction. Take a left onto Route 15 about a 1/2 mile to the fairgrounds entrance.

11. OTHER

- USEF attire and headgear rules will apply.
- Farrier on site Saturday and Sunday. Veterinarian on-call Friday – Monday AM. Contact information will be posted in the show program and in the barns.
- Horses must wear bridle numbers whenever they are being ridden or exercised (DR 121.11). Horses may only be ridden by rider, trainers, coaches and/or owners who have signed the appropriate entry form.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a maximum 6’ leash. Violators subject to \$30.00 bail.
- Schedule of warm-up arenas and lunging area will be posted in the program and in the barns.
- The management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes.
